

Interactive comment on “Geomagnetic Conjugate Observations of Ionospheric Disturbances in response to North Korea Underground Nuclear Explosion on 3 September 2017” by Yi Liu et al.

This MS reports observations of ionospheric perturbations in response to North Korea underground nuclear explosion on September 2017. By using data from the ground and satellite facilities the ionospheric disturbances in the conjugate point have been detected. Similar observations were mentioned in the earlier publication by Gokhberg et al. (1990). The authors of the present MS propose that these perturbations are results of electrodynamic process caused by LAIC electric field penetration. The paper is concisely written and contains important results. However, the MS is not free from some deficiencies described below.
